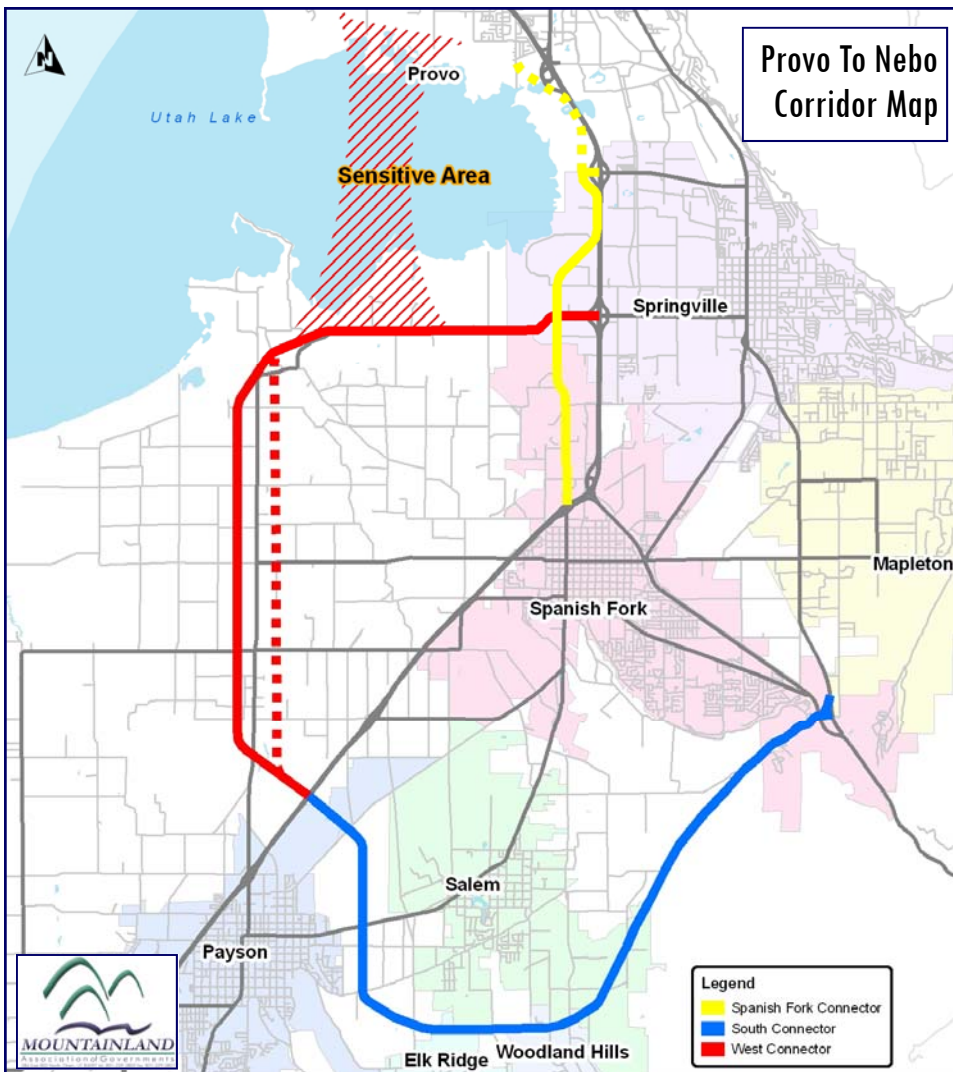


Please Join us for the
